- Please allow a minimum of 10 working days from the date of report.
- Complete the Report/Records Request Form. The form can be found online at <http://adminfin.csusb.edu/police/Forms.htm> and submitted by fax, mail, or in person at the police department.
- Once requested, please allow 2-10 business days for review. Status of the request will be made to the individual by phone, e-mail, or mail service.
- Reports can then be picked up at the Police Department once fees have been paid at the front window.
